The resulting torque, as Chinese ideas and values met the projection of American "soft" power and governmentality, created a uniquely bilateral, global imaginary where respect for China as an emerging force encountered Western reaction.

For these "old China hands", their return to the USA resulted in then-unique (and still persisting) socio-cultural formations: "bifocal" literary perspectives (Buck); correspondence celebrity (Hersey); fortress culture (Luce); and traitorcitizenship (Lattimore). As old China hands, all were keen observers of (and active participants in) international networks combining a diversity of Chinabased expertise and resources that continued to inform their everyday work at a great distance. Both public and private, these networks, onshore and off,

enabled and energised their own advocacy on behalf of a Chinese future distinct from its colonial or "semi-feudal" past.

The Flip Side asserts that these Western stakeholders occupied a transitional but crucial role in the rise of China in Western imagination prior to China's assertion of sovereignty over its own global role and message.

The term "liminal space" describes the time that exists between the ending of one stage of a person's life and the beginning of the next. Because liminal spaces are often associated with transitions, they can often be disorienting and bring an inevitable sense of uncertainty, which certainly triggers many anxieties within us due to our natural desire to feel in control of our environments. As transitional or transformative spaces, however, the associations with these realms are not necessarily negative, but can be subjectively beneficial in the challenging feelings they evoke; it can be an overwhelming sense of déjà vu, a memorable feeling of a forlorn and sadly-missed place, or the gnawing suspicion that one is on the verge of something, whether that something be terrifying or celebratory.

The word liminal comes from the Latin word limen, which translates to "threshold." They are the "waiting rooms" that hold us between one point in time and space and the next. The two words I hear the most from clients are "stuck" and "stagnant" when it comes to how they feel during these developments. My response to this popular (and very normal) feeling is often this:

Remember that we can use our period of stagnancy as an opportunity for rest. Rest is crucial for manifesting success.

Raven Grimassi (1951–2019) was a prolific occult author who had written more than twenty books on various magical, pagan, and occult topics. He is best known for his work in popularizing the branch of Italian witchcraft known as Stregheria and was an active member of the pagan community for decades. He died March 10, 2019, and is survived by not only his books but also his loving wife Stephanie, who continues to make magic in his name.

The thing your spirit ultimately longs for resides already within you. But, unfortunately, mundane life may have placed brambles in the way or created endless detours around the peace, contentment, and happiness you seek most. The good news is that a spiritual map already exists that can bypass these barriers. The way was once well-known but has been neglected over the centuries. Fortunately, our ancestors preserved the "travel guide" for us in the form of stories about the quest for the lost or hidden cauldron. Therefore, to truly benefit, you need to understand the foundational elements of cauldron myth and legend.

Myths and legends about cauldrons are incredibly ancient. In such tales, the cauldron is depicted

as a mystical or magickal vessel. These vessels are connected to themes of abundance, enlightenment, replenishment, and regeneration. The latter is our primary focus throughout this book, but we will also explore the cauldron theme as it pertains to enlightenment. We all desire to be enlightened beings, have abundance in our lives, and be able to replenish our resources. The cauldron legends hold valuable clues for us in this quest.

An examination of the legends associated with the Cauldron of Regeneration reveals that this

vessel symbolizes the womb of the Mother Goddess, the Earth itself. It is intimately connected with water (and other fluids) as well as with the Underworld or Otherworld of myth and legend. Both of these mystical realms are associated with bodies of water. In many tales of the Underworld, we find

descriptions of rivers. Legends of the Otherworld tell us of a grand island in a lake or a far-off kingdom that dwells beyond the western horizon of the sea. In metaphysical
